TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR EXPERT WITNESS WORK:

Please find below my fee structure for being an expert witness to your case(s).

Consultation Fee - £50 (+VAT)

Report writing - £850 (+VAT)

Usual payments terms are 3 months from date of invoice/report, unless otherwise negotiated before hand.

This is an inclusive capped price for the basic case, including examination, tests if required, draft report and final report after review and amendments.

Part 35 reports - 30 day payment terms.

Addendum reports for case - Charged at hourly rate (see below). 30 day payment terms.

Cancellation of consultations must be given 72 hours in advance; otherwise the minimum charge of £50 will be levied.

Additional fees after initial report :-

My hourly fee is £150 per hour for preparation, writing and investigation.

Part 35 reports will be invoiced at my hourly fee and terms are 30 days from invoice date.

My court charges are £450 minimum and £800 for a full day in court (over 4 hours).

Cancellation of court appearances must be given 72 hours in advance; otherwise the minimum charge will be levied.

The time usually required to prepare the report is 3 weeks and my terms are usually 3 months from the date of the report (although this can be negotiated in certain circumstances), an additional fee of 12% will be accrued for late payments.

Regarding the other points of my terms:

- My waiting time is usually no longer than 3 weeks.
 - I do not visit patients on a weekend.
 - I do provide Clinical Negligence reports
 - Travel charges if required can be negotiated case by case.
