#### **Responsibilities:**

I am a Consultant in Gynaecology and Reproductive Medicine and Surgery in St Mary's Hospital, one of the largest Gynaecology Units in the country. I have been awarded the title of Honorary Senior Lecturer by the University of Manchester, recognising my contribution to research. I do regular benign gynaecology clinics, cancer diagnosis clinics (rapid access), specialist infertility and outpatient hysteroscopy clinics. I carry out regular theatre lists with an interest in minimal access gynaecology and endometriosis. I participate in the on call rota managing gynaecological emergencies and early pregnancy complications. I am the chair of the monthly 'benign gynaecology MDT'. I am competent in Ultrasound scanning. I am specialised in assisted reproduction techniques, and I perform regularly oocyte collections and embryo transfers. I have led change in several aspects of gynaecology. Most recently I

implemented the use of remote consultations in gynaecology. I have published several articles in peer reviewed journals. I have a strong interest in teaching.

#### **Management of Change**

- 1. I established the benign Gynaecology MDT. This is a monthly forum where gynaecologists discuss complex cases with the contribution of histopathologists and radiologists. A variety of conditions are regularly discussed including complex fibroids, non- cancerous endometrial abnormalities and patients with complex surgical or medical problems. I am chairing the meeting since its onset in march 2021.
- 2. Standard Operating Procedure (SOP): Virtual Consultations & Remote Working in Gynaecology. I led the implementation of virtual clinics in gynaecology during the Covid-19 pandemic. I authored the relevant policy for MCS. 6/2020
- 3. Infertility Service in Wythenshawe Hospital. I built an infertility service in Wythenshawe as part of the harmonization of services within the Manchester University Foundation Trust. I introduced modern diagnostics (AMH, AFC), HyCoSy clinic. New treatment pathways were established as ovulation induction with oral agents. A smooth and faster referral pathway for patients in need of licenced treatments was established. The Unit was frequently represented in the Reproductive Medicine MDT. A dedicated fertility clinic was created. Training opportunities in infertility led to the appointment of an Infertility ATSM trainee.
- 4. Peri operative management of anti-coagulation prior to hysteroscopy. I authored the relevant policy liaising with haematology and cardiology. 2017
- 5. Management of postmenopausal bleeding. I authored the policy for MFT. 2017
- 6. Management of Pregnancy of unknown Location. I authored the local policy. 2017.
- 7. IV Iron Infusion Referral Pathway I established a screening process and referral pathway for anaemic patients in accordance with NICE guidelines, while working in a multidisciplinary team (Haemarology, Gyaecology, Anaesthetics) 3/2017
- 8. Thromboprophylaxis in HDU Audit I designed the audit proforma, collected and processed the data. Updated the relevant guideline. All patients had LMWH administered on time and appropriate dose was given. In patients at high risk of bleeding pneumatic compression stockings had not been utilised. VTE risk assessment in HDU introduced. Plan to reaudit. 2014
- 9. Laparoscopic Hysterectomy Audit I have defined the audit standards using national and international references. I supervised the data collection and the design of the audit proforma. The audit concluded to safety and efficacy of the procedure encouraging the clinicians to continue performing hysterectomies laparoscopically. 7/2017
- 10. Rescan Audit I participated in the data collection and process. Poor documentation of decision making was revealed. Repeat scans were more frequent than policy recommendation. This audit resulted in updating the local Emergency Gynae Unit

- Guideline. Recommendation for Consultant involvement after 3rd scan, urine HCG to monitor medical management. Plan to reaudit. 2014
- 11. Single Embryo Transfer (SET) Audit I have led this audit including all IVF/ICSI cycles in 2014. I have presented the results in the Departmental Meeting. As a result of this audit the SET Policy was changed. 2015
- 12. Atypical Hyperplasia Audit I processed the data and summarised the audit report.

  One patient was missed during follow up, as had migrated abroad. Improvement noted comparing to previous audits. Plan to reaudit.2014
- 13. Anaesthetic Availability Audit I have been the Clinical Lead of this Audit for 18 months, processing the data and investigating the cases that breached the national guideline. When time interval was extended, the notes were reviewed and route cause analysis was performed. The results were disseminated to the unit to increase awareness. 2013
- 14. SSR (Surgical Sperm Retrieval) Audit I designed the proforma, collected data and presented this audit, as part of the annual HFEA licence requirements. 2016
- 15. Maximum dose of gonadotrophins for follicular induction in IVF/ICSI cycles- The project confirmed the additional benefit of using 450iu of FSH as the maximum starting dose in a certain group of patients. 2017
